Interphone Tour, Sport and Urban intercoms from £109.99

Stay connected on the move

Interphone are arguably the leaders of the communications pack and they have developed a new range of systems to keep riders connected on the move.

The new range features three units to suit different types of riding from low-cost, simple units for urban commuters to more complex and costly set-ups for long-distance tourers. The Interphone Tour (£219.99) is at the top of the range, with the ability to connect up to four riders at once with a range of 1.6km. It will connect with all other types of intercom, sat-navs and smartphones through the latest Bluetooth technology. Music can be played through the smartphone or the built-in FM radio.

With a battery that will give 20 hours of talk time and up to 1000 hours on standby it'll last for the long periods

demanded by riders on tour.

The Sport unit (£169.99) has a smaller battery to allow a slimmer unit, but it'll still last a plentiful 15 hours of talk time and 1000 hours of standby. Like the Tour unit, it can be mounted to a helmet via either a clip-on bracket or self-adhesive strips and has slim-line speakers to aid comfort inside the helmet. The range on the Sport is 1km, it also connects four riders and it also has the built-in FM radio.

The cheapest new unit is the Urban (£109.99) set-up, which has a 100-metre range to allow rider and pillion to communicate. But most riders will use these as solo units to make and receive phone calls and listen to music while riding.

All three new systems are available in dealers now.
