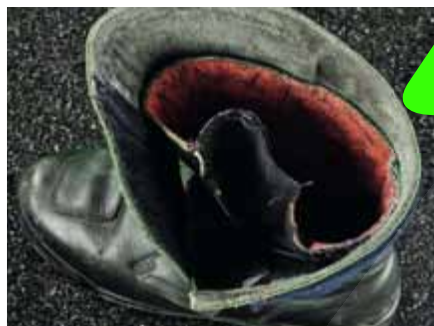
Faced with near-identical black boots in a shop, how do you choose? Trust the triangle
